K200, 000 plus raised for Team PNG

The Papua New Guinea Olympic Committee (PNGOC) has raised an amount of K204, 080.98 for Team PNG during its recent Prime Minister's Corporate Golf Challenge at the Royal Port Moresby Golf Club. A total of 50 teams registered in support of our national athletes who will be participating in the 2024 Paris Olympic Games in July.

The PM's Corporate Golf Challenge is an annual fundraiser, hosted by the Papua New Guinea Olympic Committee for Team PNG preparations towards major international games. The Golf challenge began in 1998 at the Royal Port Moresby Golf Club, and later spread to Lae in 2005. This year is the 26th year for PNGOC to host the prestigious event.
